

## SHEER PAPER LINEN BLEND IN RICE PAPER

Composition: 69% Paper, 31% Linen

Woven from a fine linen warp and a flat Japanese paper yarn in the weft, Rice Paper unites traditional craftsmanship with quiet innovation. The paper yarn, developed in Japan and inspired by the weaving of tatami mats, brings a distinctive character - gently twisting as it is woven to create a soft, organic rhythm. The dobby loom is slowed to a steady, deliberate tempo to accommodate the delicacy of these materials, allowing the interplay between crisp paper and supple linen to reveal a fabric of remarkable refinement.

At 140 cm wide, Rice Paper has a light, translucent presence, perfectly suited to curtains



where texture and purity of line are equally prized. The paper yarn lends a delicate structure and quiet graphic clarity, while the linen provides softness and natural balance. Variations in the paper yarn are intrinsic to its artisanal nature, enhancing the fabric's depth and individuality. Serene and understated, Rice Paper diffuses light with gentle luminosity - a study in texture, balance, and restraint.
